Given the degree of concern in the country about voter fraud (e.g. voter polls showing greater than 50% concern levels), it is unwise to further degrade trust in our Oregon election systems by enabling potentially fraudulent online voter registrations. The ability to simply use an SSN to register online, instead of requiring an in-person valid state photo ID presentation at the DMV or County Clerk, does not adequately protect our Oregon voter rolls against malicious actors.

Please kill this bill and instead pass measures to strengthen voter roll integrity through required voter photo ID to register and constant vigilance to keep the rolls clean.

Trading voter roll integrity for illusory increased voter access is a poor net trade and does not honor the US Constitutional promise of a truly representative republic.
