My name is Jackie Leung and I am Co-Chair of the Oregon
Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs
(OCAPIA). On behalf of the Commission, I am writing a
letter in support of HB 4058 which directs Oregon Health
Authority to create a program to acquire and distribute air
conditioners and air purifiers on emergency basis to
individuals eligible for medical assistance, in addition to
other measures that improve cooling access for Oregonians
in need.

1. OCAPIA's role is to work toward economic, social, political, and legal equity for Oregon's Asian and Pacific Islander population. We do this through advocacy, public policy research, leadership development, and partnerships.
2. In our statutory role of bringing equity focus and community voice into Oregon policy making, OCAPIA strongly supports HB 4058.

In the past several years, Oregon residents experienced severe and significant weather extremes, from increased flooding, severe ice storms, drought, wildfires, and lethal heat


