I am writing in opposition of HB4133

This bill requires electronic voter registration system to allow qualified individual to register to vote if individual has Social Security number. Requires system to enable individual to register to vote entering only final four digits of Social Security number and to electronically submit image of signature. Authorizes Secretary of State to have system include application allowing approved third-party organizations to submit registration cards electronically on behalf of individuals.

I oppose both features included in the bill. First, use of Social Security numbers is fraught with fraud. Even the IRS warns people not to use or reveal their numbers and require a two stage verification process for security. Allowing use of the last four digits for voter registration would expose our fragile voting process to additional, possible abuse.

Secondly, allowing a third party organization to submit registration cards introduces further potential abuse to our voting system. Only the voter should control this step.

This is a very concerning step our legislation is proposing. I urge you to vote against HB4133 and put it to rest for good.
