I SUPPORT [SCR 204]. "Establishes deadlines for pre-session-filed legislative measures for 2023 regular session of Eighty-second Legislative Assembly."

Taken from the Text of [SCR 204], "... (2) All requests to prepare drafts of measures must be accompanied by a brief summary of the problem sought to be addressed, the proposed solution to the problem and any other relevant information about the proposed measure...."

On issues concerning 'Public Safety', consider sending to Portland, the Joint Ways and Means Subcommittee on Public Safety (Subcommittee). Direct the Subcommittee to convene several community meetings and meet with the 'residents' in person (not just the 'Homeless' but, residential property owners, renters and the business community); in various sections of 'The Rose City' prior to the formulation and submission of measures relating to 'Public Safety' you want to have formally addressed. Do not 'soil yourselves' by meeting and discussing Public Safety issues with any Member of Portland's City Council.
