## **BUILDING CODES STRUCTURES BOARD**

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Building Codes Structures Board subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **New Appointees**

Chase Browning of Central Point Jean Root of Portland

#### Reappointee

Eric Schmidt of Portland

#### Terms

Browning: October 5, 2023 – June 30, 2027 Root: October 5, 2023 – June 30, 2027 Schmidt: July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2026

#### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 455.132 (2021)

### **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The board consists of nine members, broadly representative of the industries and professions involved in the development and construction of buildings and energy conservation, including: <sup>4</sup>

- an architect or engineer (**ROOT**);
- a general contractor specializing in the construction of buildings more than three stories above grade (DYKEMAN);
- a contractor specializing in construction for heavy industry (VACANT);
- a representative of the building trade industry (MCGRADY);
- a representative of a utility or energy supplier (HARTZOG);

- a representative of a fire protection agency (**BROWNING**);
- a building official (SCHMIDT);
- an owner or manager of a commercial office building (HEIKKINEN); and
- a representative selected from individuals recommended by the Oregon Disabilities Commission (SAMUELSON).

Members may serve two full four-year terms, and may be removed for good cause, including three unexcused absences during any 12-month period. The board meets at least twice a year; selects its chair and vice chair and sets their terms and function; and a majority constitutes a quorum.

#### **Duties**<sup>5</sup>

The board assists the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) in administering programs concerning structural, prefabricated structures, and energy programs, and accessibility for persons with physical disabilities. Its duties include:

- working with the Residential and Manufactured Structures Board and adopting design and construction standards to mitigate radon levels in specified buildings;
- selecting two members with practical construction experience to serve on the Construction Industry Energy Board; and
- reviewing proposed energy use and conservation regulations.

The board may also:6

- recommend basic and uniform performance standards to the DCBS Director for maximum energy conservation and for the use of passive solar energy in design, construction, reconstruction, alteration, and repair of buildings and other structures;
- apply for, and receive, moneys from any person, the federal government, this state, or any state agency or department; and
- contract with any public agency for the performance of services or the exchange of employees or services by one to the other necessary in developing energy conservation standards.
