ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Environmental Quality Commission subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Required.

Composition³

The commission consists of five members (BARASO, GEORGE, KILE, SCHLUSSER **WEBB**). Members serve four-year terms, and no member may serve more than two consecutive terms. ⁴

Duties

The commission establishes the policies for the operation of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) consistent with the air and water quality policies and purposes established in statute.⁵

The commission must:6

- adopt rules and standards necessary to perform duties and functions;
- appoint a Director of DEQ who holds office at the pleasure of the commission and provide policy direction to the director and agency;

- administer, license, permit, certify, and issue other authorizations related to sewage treatment and disposal, air quality, and water quality;
- administer federal air and water quality requirements;
- maintain and administer funds and grants;
- receive aid and advice from advisory committees;
- review and investigate applications and issue orders to administer air and water quality policies; and
- establish specified priorities for DEQ.

The commission may:7

- adopt administrative rules for specified fees and standards for sewage treatment and disposal, air quality, and water quality;
- grant authorization, approve specific actions by, and delegate specified duties or authorities to, DEQ, the director, the Oregon Health Authority, and other entities;
- access property records when investigating either an actual or suspected source of water or air pollution or air contamination;
- institute actions or proceedings for legal or other remedies to enforce compliance or to restrain further violations of laws;
- conduct public hearings, issue subpoenas for the production of witnesses and records, administer oaths, and make or cause to be taken depositions;
- assess, remit, or mitigate civil penalties for violations;
- accept federal funds and participate in federal matching fund programs;
- institute actions or proceedings for legal or equitable remedies to enforce compliance with specified provisions;
- enter into agreements with local governments;
- suspend or revoke specified licenses, permits, and certifications; and
- grant specified variances.
