# HEALTH EVIDENCE REVIEW COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Health Evidence Review Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

## **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of 13 members appointed by the Governor in consultation with professional and other interested organizations. Membership includes:<sup>4</sup>

- five licensed physicians who have clinical expertise in the areas of family medicine, internal medicine, obstetrics, perinatal health, pediatrics, disabilities, geriatrics, or general surgery (HOFFMAN, KANSAGARA, KAISER, LYON, OLSON, SCHABEL);
  - o one of these physicians must be an osteopathic doctor (KAISER); and

- one must be a hospital representative or a physician whose practice is significantly hospital-based (OLSON);
- one licensed dentist who has clinical expertise in general, pediatric, or public health dentistry (GEISLER);
- one public health nurse (PINZON);
- one behavioral health representative who may be a social services worker, alcohol and drug treatment provider, psychologist, or psychiatrist (LINDSEY);
- two health care consumers who are patient advocates or represent the areas of indigent services, labor, business, education, or corrections (COLLINS, SUTTON);
- one complementary or alternative medicine provider who is a licensed chiropractic physician, naturopathic physician, or acupuncturist (ESPESETE);
- one insurance industry representative who may be a medical director or other administrator (VACANT); and
- one pharmacy representative from a retail drug outlet (IRWIN).

No more than six members may be physicians, either in active practice or retired from practice. Members serve four-year terms and at the pleasure of the Governor. The commission selects one of its members as chair and another as vice chair.<sup>5</sup>

#### **Duties**

The commission develops and maintains a prioritized list of health services which are reported to the Oregon Health Authority, Legislative Assembly, and the Governor.<sup>6</sup> In completing this work, the commission must:

- regularly solicit testimony and information from stakeholders representing consumers, advocates, providers, carriers, and employers in conducting the work of the commission;
- actively solicit public involvement through a public meeting process to guide health resource allocation decisions;
- consider both the clinical effectiveness and cost effectiveness of health services, including drug therapies, in determining their relative importance using peerreviewed medical literature;
- develop and administer a medical technology assessment process to evaluate the effectiveness of research of medical technologies; and
- consult with an advisory committee in determining priorities for mental health care and chemical dependency.
