OREGON LIQUOR AND CANNABIS COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Required.

Composition³

The commission has nine Oregon residents, with no more than five belonging to the same political party.⁴ Membership includes:⁵

- One individual from each congressional district (HOLT (CD1/R), CURRIN (CD2/R), FLOYD (CD3/I), HAYS (CD4/D), GAYAPONG (CD5/N/A), VACANT (CD6);
- One individual from eastern Oregon (DOHERTY (D));
- One individual from western Oregon (MALETIS (R)); and
- One individual representing the public at large (VACANT).⁶

Each commissioner must have resided in Oregon for at least five years preceding their appointment, must be an elector, and must be at least 30 years old. One member must

represent the food and alcoholic industry (FLOYD).⁷ Other than this member, no commissioner may have a financial interest, or a household or immediate family with financial interest, in the manufacture of alcoholic beverages in Oregon. The term of office ends if the commissioner is not a resident or if industry qualification is not met. The Governor may remove any commissioner for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or misconduct in office, after providing an opportunity for hearing.⁸

Commissioners serve four-year terms from the time of appointment and qualification and until a successor qualifies for appointment. The terms of the commissioners commence April 1. Each commissioner is eligible for reappointment, limited to two full terms.

The Governor designates the chair, and the member from the food and alcoholic beverage retail industry may not serve as chair.⁹ A majority of the commissioners constitutes a quorum.

Duties¹⁰

The commission is responsible for regulating the manufacture, possession, sale, purchase, transportation, importation, and delivery of alcoholic liquor, wine, beer, cider, and marijuana in Oregon by administering the Liquor Control Act and the Control, Regulation, and Taxation of Marijuana and Industrial Hemp Act. The agency also regulates the production, processing, and sale of medical products sold to Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (OMMP) cardholders in OLCC licensed marijuana retail shops.

The commission must:

- appoint an administrator who: is the commission secretary, records custodian, and manager; administers the laws; and handles personnel;
- grant, refuse, suspend, delay, or cancel licenses or permits;
- collect specified taxes and fees and maintain specified funds;
- investigate and aide in the prosecution of statutory violations;
- adopt necessary rules and regulations;
- regulate the advertisement of alcohol;
- establish stores and warehouses for selling alcohol;

- administer the Control, Regulation, and Taxation of Marijuana and Industrial Hemp Act and portions of the Oregon Medical Marijuana Act;
- report specified information to the Legislative Assembly each biennium;
- consult and coordinate with state agencies and local government; and
- establish and consult with specified advisory committees.

The commission may:

- issue, renew, suspend, revoke, or deny licenses and permits;
- issue subpoenas, compel the attendance of witnesses and production of documents, and testimony, administer oaths, and take depositions;
- exercise all powers incidental, convenient, or necessary to enable the commission to administer or carry out its statutory duties;
- purchase, possess, seize, transfer to a licensee, or dispose of regulated product to ensure compliance;
- require the fingerprints of specified individuals; and
- investigate any potential violation of laws administered by the commission and act upon proof of violation, including the imposition of civil penalties.
