## **OREGON BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY**

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Oregon Board of Physical Therapy subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **New Appointee**

Timothy Brinker of Hillsboro

#### Term

June 5, 2024 - September 30, 2026

#### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 688.160 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

#### **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The board consists of eight Oregon residents, including:

- five physical therapists (BRINKER, CRAWFORD, LARSON REYNOLDS, OKUMURA, RENNICK);
- one licensed physical therapist assistant (SHANAHAN); and
- two public members interested in consumer rights, who are not otherwise eligible, and who are not related to a physical therapist or assistant (HAHN, TERRY).

The physical therapists or physical therapist assistants may be selected from a list of nominees submitted by the Oregon Physical Therapy Association. The physical therapists must possess unrestricted licenses, must have practiced in Oregon for at least two years immediately preceding their appointment, and must have been practiced physical therapy for at least five years.

Members serve four-year terms. A member must be removed immediately if they fail to maintain appointment criteria or have three consecutive unexcused absences.

#### Duties<sup>4</sup>

The board regulates the practice of physical therapy in Oregon.

The board must:

- administer licenses for physical therapists and physical therapist assistants and maintain a current list of licensees;
- establish and assess specified fees;
- provide public information about the procedure for filing a complaint; and
- publish final disciplinary actions taken, and other information to guide individuals regulated by the board.

The board may also:

- issue temporary permits without examination;
- impose sanctions for specified violations; and
- receive complaints and initiate investigations.
