## **QUALITY EDUCATION COMMISSION**

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Quality Education Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **Re-appointees**

Dana Hepper of Portland Tricia Mooney of Hermiston

#### Terms

November 25, 2023 - November 24, 2027

#### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 327.500 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

#### **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of 11 members, including:

- at-large members (**HEPPER**, PREUS, REXFORD, SCOTT-SCHWALBACH, SWANDER, VACANT, VACANT); and
- no more than five school district employees (COX, MOONEY, TOWNSEND, DANZUKA).

Members serve four-year terms. The Governor selects the chair and vice chair. The commission meets at the call of the chair or of a majority of commission members.

#### **Duties**

The Oregon Educational Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century established quality education goals for the state's K-12 public schools.<sup>4</sup> The commission determines the amount of funding needed to meet those goals.<sup>5</sup> The commission must:<sup>6</sup>

- each biennium, determine the amount of moneys sufficient to ensure that the state's system of K-12 public education meets the quality goals;
- identify best practices based on research, data, professional judgment, and public values that lead to high student performance and the costs of implementing those best practices in the state's K-12 public schools; and
- each biennium, issue a report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly that identifies: current practices in the state's system of K-12 public education, the costs of continuing those practices, and the expected student performance under those practices; and the best practices for meeting the quality goals, the costs of implementing the best practices, and the expected student performance under the best practices; and at least two alternatives for meeting the quality goals.
