OREGON BOARD OF NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Reappointees

Meghan Larivee of Hood River Ryan Minarik of Beaverton

Terms

July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2027

Appointment/Confirmation Authority

ORS 685.160 (2023)

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board consists of seven Oregon residents, including⁴

- five naturopathic physicians (LARIVEE, MARTIN, MINARIK, ROBLES-HERNANDEZ, WALTER); and
- two public members who are not naturopathic physicians or a spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, or sibling of a naturopathic physician (LUPER, WRIGHT).

The naturopathic physicians may be selected from a list of nominees submitted by professional organizations. They must have each practiced continuously in Oregon for the five years immediately prior to the date of appointment.

Members serve three-year terms and are eligible for reappointment, limited to two consecutive full terms. A member must be removed immediately if they fail to retain

qualifications for appointment or have three consecutive unexcused absences. The board annually elects its chair.⁵

Duties⁶

The board licenses and regulates naturopathic physicians. The board must

- administer licenses for naturopathic physicians;
- adopt and assess fees for specified services;
- when proposing discipline, give opportunity for an administrative hearing; and
- appoint a member to the Council on Naturopathic Physicians Formulary.

The board may

- offer continuing education and approve programs;
- require the fingerprints of specified individuals;
- maintain an action for an injunction against any person practicing, attempting to practice, or claiming to practice naturopathic medicine without a license;
- conduct investigations; and
- impose civil penalties up to \$5,000 for each violation.
