### **OREGONSERVES COMMISSION**

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the OregonServes Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### Reappointees

#### Terms

Altamirano Hernandez: October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2027 Carpinello and Pruch: November 19, 2024 – November 18, 2027

#### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 660.500 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

#### **Statutory Requirements**<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of 15 to 25 Oregon residents, including

- one individual with experience in educational, training and developmental needs of youth, particularly the disadvantaged (VACANT);
- one individual with experience involving adults at least 55 years of age in service and volunteerism (BASS, VANDECOEVERING);
- one community-based agency or organization representative (PRUCH);
- the Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction or designee (VACANT);
- one local governments representative (VACANT);
- one local labor unions representative (EDWARDS);
- one business representative (VACANT);

- one participant in, or supervisor of, a national service program for school-age youth, or of a campus-based or national service program, for people between 16 and 25 years of age (ALTAMIRANO HERNANDEZ);
- one national service program representative (CARPINELLO, WIROLL); and
- one volunteer sector representative (PALSHIKAR).

Membership may also include

- educators, including from a post-secondary institution of education and local education agencies (HALL, TAYLOR, NEIWORTH);
- experts in the delivery of human, educational, environmental, or public safety services (BARNES, CUMBERBATCH);
- members or representatives of Native American tribes;
- at-risk youths or out-of-school youths; and
- entities receiving assistance under the Domestic Volunteer Service Act of 1973.

Members serve three-year terms, and an individual may represent more than one category. The commission selects its chair and vice chair and must meet once a quarter. Members must have a proven commitment to community service and a demonstrated interest in fostering and nurturing civic engagement.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The Corporation for National and Community Service is the federal agency that leads volunteerism and grant-making efforts under the AmeriCorps and Senior Corps programs. States that establish a Service Commission are eligible to receive grants through those programs. OregonServes is Oregon's commission.

The commission must<sup>5</sup>

- develop, oversee, and administer programs granted by AmeriCorps;
- apply to AmeriCorps for financial assistance for state-based service programs;
- develop a three-year, comprehensive national and community service plan;
- coordinate national and volunteer service in statewide activities for disaster preparedness, response and relief activities, as well as for climate mitigation;
- promote engagement in volunteerism; and
- biennially submit a report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly.
