Public Hearing

- HB 3130 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Water Resources Department to fund staff position, or contract for services, related to voluntary agreements among ground water users from same reservoir.
- HB 2161 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Makes certain changes to calculation of small forestland owner tax credit.
- HB 2166 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Charleston Merchants Association to purchase properties for purpose of community development.
- HB 2245 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Reinstates tax credit for reforestation.
- HB 2685 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Restores availability of income or corporate excise tax credit for processing or collection of woody biomass.
- HB 3019 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Transfers revenue from levy of additional privilege tax under forest products harvest tax to State Forestry Department Account for distribution to Oregon Forest Resources Institute Fund, Oregon Forest Land Protection Fund and Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Oregon State University Extension Service to implement Oregon Environmental Literacy Plan.
