Work Session

HB 2966

Authorizes State Department of Fish and Wildlife to waive certain requirements for black bass and walleye angling competitions if department determines that limiting black bass or walleye populations would benefit native fish species or ecological health of body of water.

HB 2971 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Includes as permissible farm use for purposes of property tax special assessment operation or use of farmland subject to farm-related government program for voluntary in-stream leasing of water rights.

HB 2193

Requires State Department of Agriculture to study potential uses for animal processing waste products.

HB 2194 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to State Department of Agriculture, out of General Fund, for purpose of developing grant program to fund construction of meat rendering plants.

Public Hearing

HB 3123

Requires Oregon State University Extension Service and College of Agricultural Sciences of Oregon State University to study fate and transport of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) found in biosolids applied to agricultural fields.

HB 2835 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish pilot program to award grants for recreational fishing facilities within urban growth boundary.

HB 2799 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation for grants to erect and maintain livestock safety fencing along portions of state highway where there is high risk of conflict between traveling public and livestock.

HB 3195

Modifies definition of "public agency" for purposes of eligibility for financial assistance from Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund by removing requirement that agency be authorized to construct water pollution control facilities.

HB 3159 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Increases state transient lodging tax.
