- HB 2998 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Creates Oregon Soil Health Initiative.
- HB 3098
Directs State Department of Agriculture, in consultation with Pesticide Analytical and Response Center, to establish farmworker outreach program.
- HB 2610 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Oregon State University to research reduced-risk pest management tools for Oregon's specialty crops and report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2027.
- HB 2647
Declares harmful algal blooms to be menace to public health and welfare.
- HB 2248
Requires Water Resources Department and Department of Environmental Quality to study impacts of wildfire on water quality of streams and tributaries.
- HB 2835 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish pilot program to award grants for recreational fishing facilities within urban growth boundary.
- HB 3125 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Public Drinking Water and Sewer Ratepayer Assistance Fund.
- HB 3142
Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to provide grants to counties and soil and water conservation districts for removal of western juniper.
- HB 3187
Makes individuals employed seven or more years by certain types of districts eligible to apply for certification as water right examiners.

HB 3247 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for allocation to Oregon State University through Oregon Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory, for specified purposes related to zoonotic disease.
