HB 3157 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Health Insurance Mandate Review Advisory Committee to review each proposed legislative measure, legislative concept or amendment that requires health insurer or health care service contractor to reimburse cost of specified procedure or provider, if measure, concept or amendment is posted to legislative committee's agenda, and to produce report on equity and financial effects of each required coverage that is proposed and efficacy of treatment or service proposed.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish accreditation program for substance use disorder treatment programs.

HB 2627

Adds two members who are physician assistants or retired physician assistants to membership of Oregon Medical Board.

HB 2486

Allows certain pharmacy technicians to administer vaccines.

HB 2617 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with Newborn Bloodspot Screening Advisory Board, to adopt rules for board to evaluate and recommend adding disease to or removing disease from newborn bloodspot screening panel or taking no action on disease.

HB 2608 **

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for specified expenses. HB 2445

Authorizes independent behavioral health certification entity that meets specified requirements to certify addiction peer support specialists to work with coordinated care organizations.

HB 2600

Requires Governor, in appointing members to Oregon State Board of Nursing, to balance diversity of setting in which nurse or certified nursing assistant members provide care.

HB 2994

Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of hearing-related items and services. HB 2048

Directs Health Licensing Office to issue provisional registration to applicant for behavior analysis interventionist registration.

HB 2574 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires hospitals to adopt policies and procedures to ensure provision of human immunodeficiency virus post-exposure prophylactic drugs or therapies following patient's possible exposure to human immunodeficiency virus.

HB 2996

Prohibits Oregon Board of Dentistry from requiring applicant for certification as dental assistant to pass written examination for radiological proficiency.

HB 3007 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish Oral Health Advisory Committee and Office of Oral Health.

HB 3008

Limits ability of carriers offering dental benefit to require reimbursement of claims by credit card or electronic funds transfer.

HB 3040

Requires coordinated care organizations to share claims and encounter data with provider regarding patients that provider contracts with coordinated care organization to serve.

HB 3223

Prohibits Oregon Board of Dentistry from requiring applicant for certification as dental assistant to pass written examination.
