Public Hearing

HB 2420

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules allowing county registrar to issue and sell records of live births and deaths occurring in any county of state.

HB 3096

Includes nursing technicians as staff that may be considered in establishing hospital staff nursing plans.

HB 2617 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Directs Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with Newborn Bloodspot Screening Advisory Board, to adopt rules for board to evaluate and recommend adding disease to or removing disease from newborn bloodspot screening panel or taking no action on disease.

HB 2608 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for specified expenses.

HB 2445

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Authorizes independent behavioral health certification entity that meets specified requirements to certify addiction peer support specialists to work with coordinated care organizations.

HB 2600

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Requires Governor, in appointing members to Oregon State Board of Nursing, to balance diversity of setting in which nurse or certified nursing assistant members provide care.

HB 2994

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of hearing-related items and services.

HB 2048

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Directs Health Licensing Office to issue provisional registration to applicant for behavior analysis interventionist registration.

HB 2574 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Requires hospitals to adopt policies and procedures to ensure provision of human immunodeficiency virus post-exposure prophylactic drugs or therapies following patient's possible exposure to human immunodeficiency virus.

HB 2996

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Prohibits Oregon Board of Dentistry from requiring applicant for certification as dental assistant to pass written examination for radiological proficiency.

HB 3007 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish Oral Health Advisory Committee and Office of Oral Health.

HB 3008

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Limits ability of carriers offering dental benefit to require reimbursement of claims by credit card or electronic funds transfer.

HB 3223

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Prohibits Oregon Board of Dentistry from requiring applicant for certification as dental assistant to pass written examination.

HB 2696 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Authorizes Health Licensing Office to issue sign language interpreter license to qualified applicant.

HB 2486

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-6-2023 MEETING: Allows certain pharmacy technicians to administer vaccines.
