HB 3022

CARRIED OVER FROM 2-8-23 MEETING: Prohibits Environmental Quality Commission and Department of Environmental Quality from adopting or enforcing rules or standards related to motor vehicle fuels or emissions unless authorized by Legislative Assembly by law enacted on or after effective date of Act.

HB 2534

Requires State Department of Energy to work with stakeholders to identify areas of inquiry regarding energy and energy use in this state, develop research options and convene advisory group to develop recommendations and benchmarks around energy and energy use in this state.

HB 3160

Modifies period of suspension of proposed utility rate or schedule of rates pending investigation and determination from initial six-month period plus additional three-month period to single nine-month period.

HB 3161

Removes requirement that electric company file separate implementation plan for meeting requirements of renewable portfolio standard.

HB 2215 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Agriculture, Land Use, Natural Resources, and Water

Removes requirement that adequate repository for terminal disposition of high-level radioactive waste be licensed as precondition for issuance of site certificate for nuclear-fueled thermal power plant.
