Directs Housing and Community Services Department to provide financial assistance to eligible applicants to pay for allowable costs related to early child care infrastructure activities.

HB 2727

Directs Department of Land and Conservation and Development to convene work group to examine strategies for expanding early learning and care facilities in this state.

HB 2454 **

HB 2479

Grants certain immunities to children's advocacy centers and to employees and designated agents of children's advocacy centers.
