HB 3009 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Human Services to establish and administer program to provide services to youth with acute needs and families of such youth.

HB 2869

Requires Department of Human Services to study programs and services administered by aging and disability services division of department.

HB 3303

Establishes Community Information Exchange Board and specifies membership and duties.

HB 2440

Requires entity participating in community information exchange to access, use or disclose information consistent with authorization provided by individual or personal representative of individual.
