SB 599 A

Requires landlord to allow dwelling to be used as family child care home, subject to conditions. SB 968 A

Modifies duties of System of Care Advisory Council.

Work Session

SB 769 A

Prohibits department from determining that individual is unfit solely based on substantiated or founded allegation of abuse arising from acts of individual when under 18 years of age.

SB 202 A

Directs Department of Human Services to develop and administer voluntary placement program to provide supports to certain young adults as they transition to adulthood.

SB 208 A

Grants juvenile court continuing wardship jurisdiction upon establishment of permanent guardianship, regardless of whether original bases for wardship jurisdiction continue to exist.

SB 209 A

Prohibits certain persons from disclosing records of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression of child or ward.

SB 210 A

Requires Department of Human Services to study exceptions to mandatory abuse reporting requirements of department employees who provide assistance to domestic violence victims.

SB 231

Directs Department of Human Services to establish and maintain centralized child abuse reporting system.

SB 901

Confers authority to Director of Human Services to issue investigative subpoenas for production of specified records in child abuse investigations.
