#### Work Session

SB 757

Requires that whenever notice of founded disposition of child abuse is delivered to perpetrator, notice must also be delivered to perpetrator's attorney, if applicable.

SB 823 A

Directs Department of Human Services to prepare completed abuse investigation report at conclusion of specified child abuse investigations.

SB 769 A

Prohibits department from determining that individual is unfit solely based on substantiated or founded allegation of abuse arising from acts of individual when under 18 years of age.

SB 93 A

Modifies juvenile court procedure to include Department of Human Services as party to proceedings if department has taken child or ward into protective custody.

SB 1016 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-10-2023 MEETING: Directs Department of Human Services to establish and maintain regional family support networks for families of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

SB 865 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-10-2023 MEETING: Directs Department of Human Services to begin search for relative placement resources immediately upon child or ward entering substitute care.

SB 548 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-10-2023 MEETING: Directs Department of Human Services to maintain inventory of luggage carriers for use when transporting personal effects of foster children.

SB 574 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-10-2023 MEETING: Authorizes school district to use public funds for out-of-state placement of students only if specified criteria are satisfied.

SB 901

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-10-2023 MEETING: Confers authority to Director of Human Services to issue investigative subpoenas for production of specified records in child abuse investigations.

SB 1024 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-10-2023 MEETING: Modifies provisions regarding retention of records of incidents involving the use of restraints or seclusion of children in care and students in public education programs.

**Public Hearing and Work Session**

SB 105 A

Expands definition of "abuse" to include restraint or seclusion of or infliction of corporal punishment on adult with developmental disability by public education program, for purposes of complaints of abuse to and investigation of complaints by Department of Human Services.

SB 794

Exempts certain providers of adoption placement services from specified reporting requirements.
