HB 2280

Modifies requirements of consent for purposes of school district sexual harassment policies.

Public Hearing

HB 2240

Exempts from health care interpreter requirements individuals providing services as employees or contractors of school districts, public charter schools and education service districts.

HB 2646 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Department of Education to provide program to train school employees on signs and symptoms of mental illness, psychiatric or psychological disorder, depression or substance abuse disorder, de-escalating mental health or substance use disorder crisis and assisting students in crisis.

HB 2618

Requires Department of Education to conduct study to identify best methodology for determining appropriate number of students on caseload for certain school-based health practitioners.
