HB 3059

Requires Oregon Department of Emergency Management to study emergency management.

HB 2854 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Oregon Public Assistance Grant Account as account in Oregon Disaster Response Fund.

HB 2873 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes issuance of general obligation bonds under Article XI-Q of Oregon Constitution for emergency preparedness equipment grant program.

HB 3209

Establishes emergency veterans housing program within Housing and Community Services Department.
