**Public Hearing**

HB 3387 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Lowers normal retirement age and earliest retirement age for member of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan who has 25 years or more of retirement credit as police officer or firefighter, regardless of whether person retires from service as police officer or firefighter.

SB 853 A  
Prohibits state from paying costs of travel to or from Oregon for employee in state service who telecommutes from principal worksite more than 60 miles outside this state, unless collective bargaining agreement provides otherwise or essential requirements of position make it necessary for employee to telecommute from outside this state.

HB 2914 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Task Force on Abandoned and Derelict Vessels.

HB 2701 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Increases retirement benefits and lowers normal retirement age under Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan for telecommunicators and employees of Oregon State Hospital.

HB 3515  
Provides that city with population greater than 600,000 may refer ballot measure to electors to form park and recreation district and have entirety of governing body of city serve as entirety of membership of board of district so formed.

HB 3531  
Requires owner of public building to periodically conduct inspections and testing of fire dampers, smoke dampers, combination fire and smoke dampers and smoke control systems in public building.

HB 3572  
Requires contracting agency to grant preference to procuring for public use goods or services that are provided by benefit company incorporated, organized, formed or created under laws of this

state, if goods or services cost not more than five percent more than goods or services available from contractor that is not benefit company.

HB 3387 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Lowers normal retirement age and earliest retirement age for member of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan who has 25 years or more of retirement credit as police officer or firefighter, regardless of whether person retires from service as police officer or firefighter.

HB 3421  
Requires official ceremony or other event held by state government to commemorate Memorial Day or Veterans Day to be held on legal holiday.
