HB 3387 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Lowers normal retirement age and earliest retirement age for member of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan who has 25 years or more of retirement credit as police officer or firefighter, regardless of whether person retires from service as police officer or firefighter.

SB 853 A

Prohibits state from paying costs of travel to or from Oregon for employee in state service who telecommutes from principal worksite more than 60 miles outside this state, unless collective bargaining agreement provides otherwise or essential requirements of position make it necessary for employee to telecommute from outside this state.

HB 2650

HB 2948 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Directs Oregon Department of Emergency Management to develop and implement program to award grants for fairgrounds used as emergency evacuation sites.

HB 2178

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Requires state agencies to include, as part of agency request budget, analysis of extent to which goods and services can be acquired from work programs operated by Department of Corrections or Oregon Corrections Enterprises.

HB 3260

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Authorizes self-service dispensing of Class 1 flammable liquids at retail dispensary in rural Oregon.

HB 2904

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Requires institution or research facility that performs research, testing or studies involving nonhuman primates to annually report certain information to State Veterinarian.

HB 3059

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Requires Oregon Department of Emergency Management to study emergency management.

HB 3209

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Establishes emergency veterans housing program within Housing and Community Services Department.

HB 2865

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Specifies leave of absence entitled for public employee for initial active duty for training and annual active duty training as member of National Guard, National Guard Reserve or reserve component of Armed Forces of the United States or of United States Public Health Service is for days that are work days.

HB 2283

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-30-2023 MEETING: Modifies provisions relating to public employee retirement.

HB 2914 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on Abandoned and Derelict Vessels.

HB 2701 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases retirement benefits and lowers normal retirement age under Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan for telecommunicators and employees of Oregon State Hospital.

HB 3515

Provides that city with population greater than 600,000 may refer ballot measure to electors to form park and recreation district and have entirety of governing body of city serve as entirety of membership of board of district so formed.

HB 3572

Requires contracting agency to grant preference to procuring for public use goods or services that are provided by benefit company incorporated, organized, formed or created under laws of this state, if goods or services cost not more than five percent more than goods or services available from contractor that is not benefit company.

HB 3387 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Lowers normal retirement age and earliest retirement age for member of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan who has 25 years or more of retirement credit as police officer or firefighter, regardless of whether person retires from service as police officer or firefighter.

HB 3421

Requires official ceremony or other event held by state government to commemorate Memorial Day or Veterans Day to be held on legal holiday.

HB 3486

Designates certain newly constructed structures in schools and community colleges as earthquake relief shelters.
