#### Work Session

- HB 2653 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures  
Creates credit against income taxes for selling publicly supported housing to retain as affordable housing.
- HB 3042  
Limits terminations and rent increases for three years after tenants' housing is withdrawn from publicly supported housing.
- HB 2634  
Defines "recreational vehicle park" for the purposes of residential tenancy law.
- HB 3215 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Authorizes Housing and Community Services Department to support replacement, reconstruction or rehabilitation of residential units damaged or destroyed by disaster and to support recovery of residents of such housing.

*The following bill is scheduled solely for the purpose of moving the bill to the House Committee on Revenue.*

- HB 3010 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures  
Limits, for purposes of personal income taxation, amount of allowed mortgage interest deduction.

#### Public Hearing

- HB 2987  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to study grants under Healthy Homes Program.
- HB 3462  
Requires Oregon Department of Emergency Management, during certain emergencies, to prioritize immediate provision of housing to displaced individuals.
- HB 3482  
Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development to study housing.
