Public Hearing

- HB 2309 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires law enforcement agencies to take DNA sample of person arrested for certain crimes.
- HB 3213
Prohibits manufacturer from selling or offering to sell cosmetic developed through use of cosmetic animal test.

Work Session

- HB 2427 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Modifies mileage rate paid to witnesses for travel to and from civil and criminal proceedings.
- HB 2931
Requires Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to study cannabis.
- HB 3148
Authorizes peace officer to request order from circuit court for information regarding missing individual.
