Work Session

- HB 2308 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires that each district attorney in state be paid same salary.
- HB 2309 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires law enforcement agencies to take DNA sample of person arrested for certain crimes.
- HB 2320
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-28-2023 MEETING: Establishes Juvenile Justice Advisory Commission within Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.
- HB 2391 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-28-2023 MEETING: Appropriates moneys for 2023-2025 biennium to Oregon Department of Administrative Services to fund county victim assistance programs.
- HB 2479
Grants certain immunities to children's advocacy centers and to employees and designated agents of children's advocacy centers.
- HB 2519
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-28-2023 MEETING: Prohibits acceptance of consideration for displaying human remains to public.
- HB 2919
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-28-2023 MEETING: Provides that registered nurse providing patient care in good faith is immune from criminal liability for act or omission that is part of provision of care unless offense has intentional or knowing culpable mental state.
- HB 3213
Prohibits manufacturer from selling or offering to sell cosmetic developed through use of cosmetic animal test.
- HB 3294
Requires county clerk to replace recorded instrument with court-ordered version that redacts discriminatory language.

HB 3571

Establishes immunity from prosecution for theft in first degree and civil liability for nonprofit animal rescue entity that takes possession of, keeps and disposes of cat or dog as provided in Act.

SB 305

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-28-2023 MEETING: Modifies provisions relating to special motions to strike.

HB 2467 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Public Defense Services Student Loan Repayment Assistance Program in Oregon State Bar to provide forgivable loans to eligible public defense attorneys for outstanding student loans.

HB 2672 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Public Law School Tuition Forgiveness program.

HB 3582

Establishes procedure for charging aggravated version of certain assault and attempted murder offenses when defendant causes permanent physical injury to victim during commission of crime.

Note change: HB 2320, HB 2391, HB 2519, HB 2919 and SB 305 have been carried over.
