Work Session

SB 234

Expands authority of Chief Justice of Supreme Court to make rules for gathering specified information and identifying and evaluating disparities and impacts in justice system in Oregon.

SB 317

Provides that requirement that certain hearsay statements of unavailable witnesses concerning acts of abuse must be supported by corroborative evidence applies in juvenile delinquency proceedings.

SB 339 A

Authorizes court to require as condition of probation for person convicted of harassment completion of sex offender treatment program and submission to polygraph examinations, if recommended by probation officer and if harassment involved touching of sexual or intimate parts of another person.

SB 529

Modifies legislative findings concerning alternative incarceration programs.

SB 618 A

Directs court to consider, when determining aggravation at sentencing, whether defendant was wearing body armor at time of crime.

SB 816 A

Modifies duration of Family Abuse Prevention Act restraining orders .
