Work Session

SB 211

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-3-2023 MEETING: Repeals sunset on requirement for Department of Corrections to provide training for basic certification of corrections officers employed by department.

SB 234

Expands authority of Chief Justice of Supreme Court to make rules for gathering specified information and identifying and evaluating disparities and impacts in justice system in Oregon.

SB 568 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-3-2023 MEETING: Provides that court is not required to hold hearing on petition to vacate defendant's requirement to install and use ignition interlock device while participating in diversion program.

Public Hearing

SB 326 A

Requires owner of real property where site of unlawful manufacture of marijuana or unlawful production of marijuana is located to clean up waste from site upon receipt of notification from law enforcement agency.

SB 954 A

Allows circuit court judge to authorize execution of search warrant outside judicial district for interrelated conduct carried on in more than one county.

Note change: SB 787 removed.
