#### Public Hearing

- HB 3221 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Increases amounts of moneys that are not considered Local Revenues for purposes of State School Fund distributions to school districts.
- HB 2767 A\*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes requirements for approving recovery schools.
- SB 206  
Amends and repeals statutes to eliminate conflict between certain grants of property taxation authority and constitutional requirements related to property taxation.
- SB 981  
Authorizes Oregon Department of Administrative Services to exempt certain accounts that originate in Department of Revenue from general requirement to assign liquidated and delinquent account to private collection agency within one year of most recent payment on account.

#### Informational Meeting

- HB 2199  
**Carried over from 4/18/2023 meeting. (Time Permitting)**  
Extends sunset date of enterprise zone program.
- HB 3011  
**Carried over from 4/18/2023 meeting. (Time Permitting)**  
Provides for transparency and coordination when local governments enter into agreements for property tax exemptions with business firms.
