HB 2757 A

Expands and provides funding for coordinated crisis services system including 9-8-8 suicide prevention and behavioral health crisis hotline.

#### Informational Meeting

HB 3457

Indexes minimum total cost of eligible project under strategic investment program to increase, if any, in consumer price index.
