HB 2099

Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings.

HB 2100

Directs Department of Transportation to study issues related to transportation funding and to report to appropriate committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2024.

HB 2137 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Willamette River Bridge Task Force.

HB 2101 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Transportation to establish local transportation program to provide state funding in exchange for federal surface transportation funding available to cities and counties.

HB 3551

Increases maximum weight cutoff for eligibility of aircraft for 60 percent valuation for purposes of property taxation of mobile property of air transportation companies.

HB 3113 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation, for biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for improving safety and increasing access to walking, biking and transit on state highways that serve as community main streets.

HB 3550

Requires state agency that purchases or leases light-duty vehicle on and after January 1, 2025, to purchase only zero-emission vehicle unless state agency finds that zero-emission vehicle is not feasible for specific use state agency has for light-duty vehicle.
