Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 416

Requires public universities and community colleges to pay part-time faculty at same rate, on per-hour basis, as public university or community college pays full-time faculty to prepare for and teach course.

SB 768

Requires Department of Education to conduct study to determine feasibility of collecting student course grade history in grades 6 through 12.

SB 275

Requires Department of Education, Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and Educator Advancement Council to conduct study to identify best means of improving alignment among state education agencies.

SB 1002

Eliminates State School Fund distributions for facility grants.

SB 1045

Directs Department of Education to review department's statutes, rules and internal policies to identify how best to incorporate suggestions made by Secretary of State following audit of education in this state.

Work Session

SB 290

Clarifies education duties of State Board of Education, Department of Education, Superintendent of Public Instruction and district school boards.

SB 518

Specifies contract price at which apprentice utilization requirements apply to qualified contracts with institutions of higher education and school districts.

SB 523

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission plan regarding applied baccalaureate degrees to include name and type of applied baccalaureate degrees to be conferred.
