#### Public Hearing

SB 522

Changes name of "Oregon Global Warming Commission" to "Oregon Climate Action Commission." Modifies membership and duties of commission.

SB 852

Directs State Department of Energy to establish program to provide assistance related to energy projects and activities to environmental justice communities.

#### Work Session

SB 64

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study disposal of electric vehicle batteries and batteries used to store energy in wind or solar renewable energy facilities.
