SB 1015 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures  
Allows taxpayer to fully depreciate, over two tax years, property that shows demonstrable reduction in carbon emissions.

#### Work Session

SB 145 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures  
Creates sunset of tax exemption for property of certain cooperatives used to heat water by combustion of biomass.

SB 444 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Environmental Quality to establish Recycling Innovators Grant Program.

SB 630 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds and transfer of net proceeds to Oregon Business Development Department.

*Senate Bill 1083 is scheduled solely for the purpose of moving the bill to another committee.*

SB 1083  
Exempts hybrid motor vehicles and motor vehicles with model years that predate by six years or less date of registration or renewal of registration from requirement to be equipped with certified pollution control system.
