HB 3055 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-16-2023 MEETING: Requires Public Utility Commission to establish eligibility cap for standard avoided costs rates and contracts for purchase of energy or energy and capacity from qualifying facilities at no less than 10 megawatts.

HB 3179 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-16-2023 MEETING: Modifies definition of "renewable energy facility" for purposes of county permitting process for solar photovoltaic power generation facility.
