SB 818

Directs Oregon Health Authority to develop list of suicide risk assessment and treatment continuing education opportunities for specified physical health care providers.

- SB 704 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes Universal Health Plan Governance Board and directs board to create comprehensive plan for implementing Universal Health Plan beginning in 2027.
- SB 558

Exempts from regulation by Advisory Council on Hearing Aids and Health Licensing Office over-the-counter hearing aid.

### Public Hearing

SB 965

Allows Oregon Health Authority to conduct off-site investigation after receiving certain complaints against hospitals.

SB 968

Requires Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with System of Care Advisory Council, to study Oregon's systems of care.

SB 967

Allows Oregon Health Authority to reimburse coordinated care organizations using payment mechanisms other than global budgets under specified circumstances.

SB 966

Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt standards for types of data collected for all payer, all claims database that are consistent with standards adopted for collection of data on race, ethnicity, language, disability status, sexual orientation and gender identity.
