#### Public Hearing

- SB 91 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Department of Human Services to request from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services approval of waiver to obtain federal financial participation in costs of program to pay parents of minor children with disabilities to provide attendant care services to children.
- SB 646 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to request federal approval to allow parent or legal guardian to be paid to act as personal support worker or direct support professional for minor child who has intellectual or developmental disability.
- SB 773  
Authorizes Superintendent of Public Instruction to require school district to reimburse parent or foster parent for reasonable expenses incurred by parent or foster parent while student was placed on abbreviated school day program in violation of requirements for program.

#### Work Session

- SB 790  
Modifies definition of "abuse" for purposes of child abuse to include violations of existing laws prohibiting infliction of corporal punishment on students and use of restraint and seclusion on students.
- SB 574 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Prohibits use of public funds for out-of-state residential placement of students.
