- SB 576 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires Department of Human Services to administer program to provide medical assistance to employed individuals with disabilities without regard to individuals' income or resources.
- SB 569 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires closed-captioned television receivers in public areas within places of public accommodation to display closed captioning unless exception applies.
- SB 685  
Modifies definition of "communication facilitator."
