Public Hearing

- SB 1016 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services to establish and maintain regional family support networks for families of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- SB 105
Requires Department of Human Services to study delivery of developmental disability services statewide.
- SB 792
Requires Department of Human Services to report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health, no later than September 15, 2024, on implementation of agency with choice.

Work Session

- SB 820
Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide community-based services and supports to individuals with complex mental or behavioral health needs who are under 21 years of age.
- SB 1024
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/13/2023 AGENDA: Modifies provisions regarding retention of records of incidents involving the use of restraints or seclusion of children in care and students in public education programs.
- SB 609
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/13/2023 AGENDA: Directs Department of Human Services to consider hours worked as graduate assistant as hours worked in employment for purpose of meeting work requirements in Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program.
