Informational Meeting

SB 348

Invited Speakers Only

Members may provide statements at the informational as time permits.

For the purposes of consideration of the -1 amendments only.

Directs Department of Justice to study ways to address unlawful possession of firearms, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024.

Public Hearing

SB 527

Allows gun dealer or person transferring firearms, firearm accessories, ammunition or ammunition components for purchase at gun show, or business engaged in repairing or servicing firearms to establish minimum age of 21 years for such purchases, repairs or services.

Work Session

SB 343

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-23-2023 MEETING: Directs Department of Transportation to study issues related to driving privileges and to report to appropriate committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2024.

SB 519

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-23-2023 MEETING: Modifies procedure for expunction of certain juvenile records.

HB 2645 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-23-2023 MEETING: Increases penalties for possession of certain amounts of fentanyl.
