Public Hearing

HB 2129

Exempts from prosecution for unlawfully obtaining contents of communication person who did not participate in initially obtaining communication regarding matter of public concern.

HB 2130

Removes requirement that Attorney General appoint service provider and adopt rules for operation of environmental claims mediation program.

HB 2405 A

Requires that court dismissing charges involving orders of commitment due to defendant lacking fitness to proceed also order transport of defendant back to jurisdiction in which charges were initiated.

HB 2292

Provides, with respect to contract with landscape contracting business, right of rescission within three business days after contract execution.
