#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 119

Requires Department of Transportation, Oregon Department of Administrative Services and any contracting agency that uses funds from American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 to study use of apprentices in projects for public works and other public improvement projects.

SB 616

Allows holder of direct shipper permit to ship up to five cases of cider or malt beverages, each containing not more than nine liters, per month to Oregon resident.

#### Public Hearing

SB 128

Provides that, for purposes of determining salary of certain member of Public Employees Retirement System, housing allowance paid to prison chaplain shall be treated as includable in member's taxable income under Oregon law.

SB 194

Makes permanent provision excluding certain employees of Oregon State Police from meaning of supervisory employee for purposes of public employment.

SB 195

Excludes hours of overtime worked for Oregon State Police from limitations on inclusion of overtime in final average salary for purposes of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan.

SB 304 \*\*

Establishes Task Force on Occupational Licensing.
