Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2573 A

Requires Employment Relations Board to develop guidelines and procedures for authorizations designating bargaining representatives of bargaining unit to be prepared and signed electronically.

HB 2620

Punishes violation of laws that regulate home solicitation sales as unlawful practice under Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

HB 2864

Expands list of employees that may be charged certain representation fees to include employees of Department of Corrections and of Oregon Corrections Enterprises, and parole and probation officers who supervise adult offenders.

HB 3331

Amends eligibility requirements for employee to receive benefits under shared work plan.
