#### Work Session

SB 956

Instructs Water Resources Commission to take certain actions related to Walla Walla Water 2050 Strategic Plan.

SB 951

Provides that certified parole and probation officer employed by State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision qualifies as police officer under Public Employees Retirement System.

SB 455 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-27-2023 MEETING: Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish and administer grant program for aquifer recharge due diligence and forgivable loan program for aquifer recharge testing.

SB 634 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds for deposit in Levee Project Grant Fund.

SB 130 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Extends sunset for tax credit for fish screening devices.

SB 132 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Extends sunset for tax credits for owner or operator of agriculture workforce housing.

#### Public Hearing

SB 644

Removes certain requirements relating to wildfire risk maps for development of accessory dwelling units on lands zoned for rural residential use.

SB 220

Requires payment of additional 25 percent surcharge on certain assessments by State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

SB 221

Establishes Electronic Permitting System Subaccount.

SB 222

Authorizes State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to accept payments by credit card and to add fee to credit card transactions.
