HB 3211 A

Authorizes holder of certain water right certificates that authorize storage of water for municipal use to change authorized point of diversion and place of use without losing priority of right under specified circumstances.

Public Hearing

HB 2411

Dissolves Oregon Alfalfa Seed Commission.

HB 2689

Provides licensing exemption for person slaughtering not more than 1,000 rabbits for use as human food.

HB 2687 A

Authorizes State Department of Agriculture to issue public applicator licenses and public trainee certificates to employees of federally recognized Indian tribes for purposes of pesticide application on lands other than Indian country.

HB 2966 A

Authorizes State Department of Fish and Wildlife to waive certain requirements for black bass and walleye angling competitions if department determines that limiting black bass or walleye populations would benefit native fish species or ecological health of body of water.
