Work Session

HB 3343 A

Modifies qualifications for water well constructor's license.

HB 3485 A

Provides State Fire Marshal with certain additional discretionary powers.

HB 3440

Allows counties with population between 200,000 and 650,000 to elect to distribute receipts from sales of certain lands and mineral rights through alternative mechanism.

HB 2929 A

Authorizes Water Resources Department to seek injunctive relief if person has engaged, or is about to engage, in activity that is or will be violation of certain water laws.

HB 3362 A

Allows county to validate unit of land that had been approved for recognition that was later revoked after sale to innocent purchaser.

HB 2238 A

Authorizes method by which Department of State Lands may dispose of personal property left on state lands.

Public Hearing

HB 3458 A

Limits issues that may be basis for appeal of land use decisions where local government amends comprehensive plan or land use regulations.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3464 A

Provides, for purposes of certain statutes relating to taking of predatory animals, that term "predatory animal" does not include beavers.
