Public Hearing

SB 160

Requires certain public bodies to reduce public records request fees by 40 percent if request is made in public interest.

SB 417

Directs public bodies to perform search, review and duplication work in responding to public records requests in least expensive manner reasonably possible.

SB 510

Directs Public Records Advocate to estimate biennial costs to carry out duties of advocate and to allocate and assess costs among public bodies of state government.

The following bill is scheduled solely for the purpose of referring to the Senate President for referral to another committee.

Work Session

SB 178

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to study and make recommendations for policy proposals for tax treatment of military pensions.

SCR 1

Expresses support for county clerks and local election officials.
